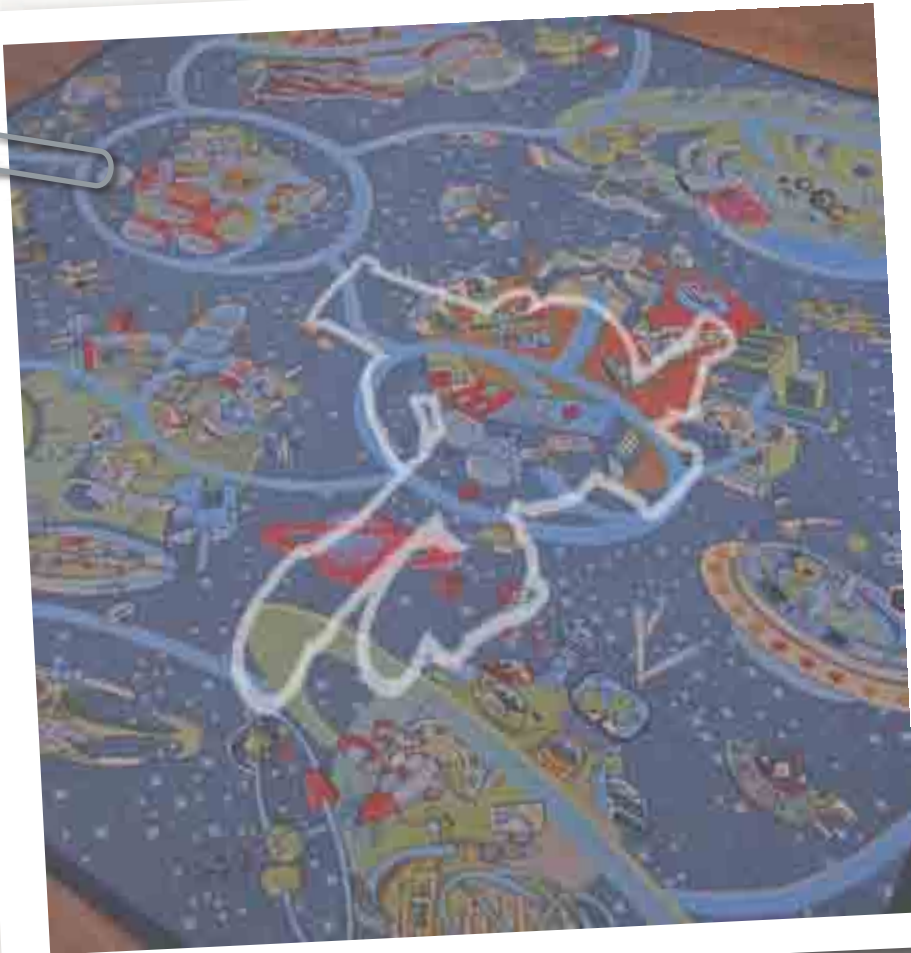
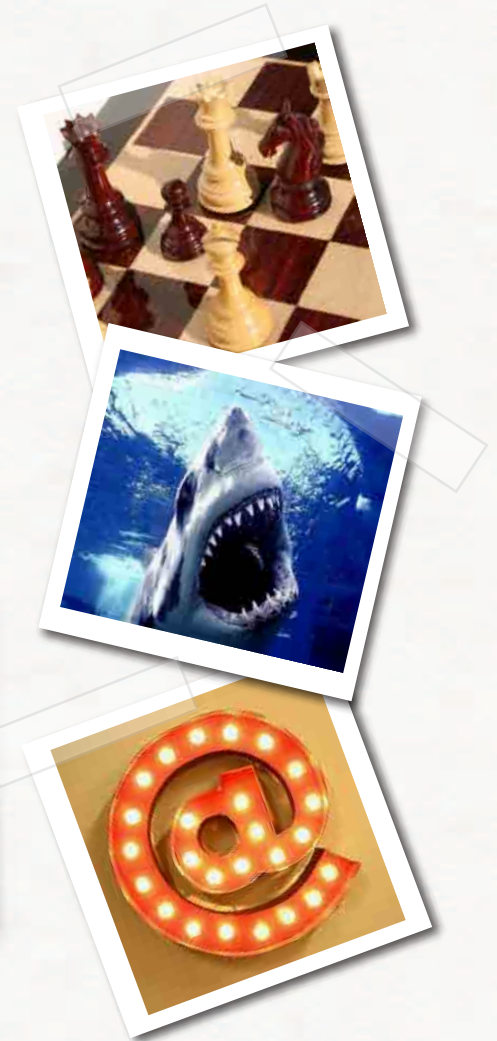

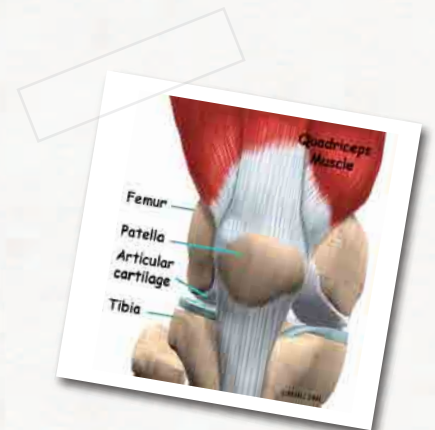
CRIME SCENE NOTES

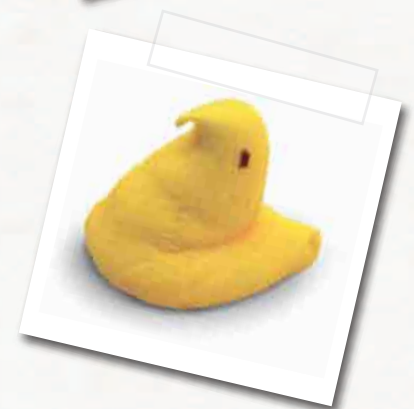

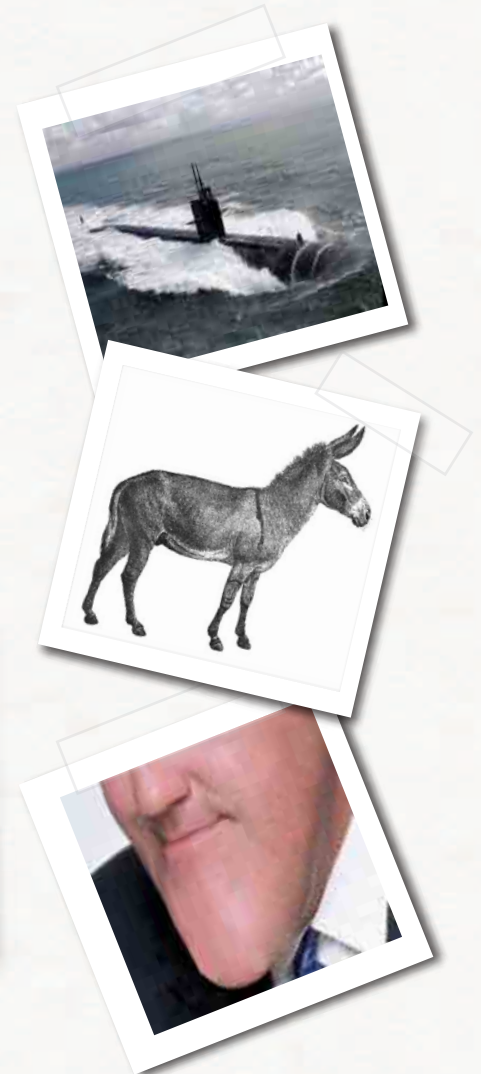
CRIME SCENE NOTES
