

This puzzle uses triple homophones. The ‘strange sort of sense’ is weakly clued by the fact that the next sentence of the flavor text uses “they’re”, “their” and “there”.

There are a few cases (like ‘small child’ + ‘under high tension’) where the spacing in the middle means neither side’s answer fits, which is a good place to cue the need for a triplet. The number of spaces in shift-6’s middle rules out ‘carrot’ as an answer

The Temple of Apollo at Delphi

Archaeologists propose that the prophecies of the oracles in the Temple of Apollo were powered by toxic fumes from naturally-occurring fissures. It may have been crazy ranting in Greek, but in English, the following gibberish makes a strange sort of sense. They’re missing their middle pieces, but maybe the clues can tell you what belongs there.

heeled (SOLED)≠	S O L D (3,1)	# (SOULED) imbued with a spirit
board for a painter (PALETTE)≠	P A L A T E (6,3)	# (PALLET) wooden shipping platform
hunts for food (PREYS)≠	P R A I S E (3,4)	# (PRAYS) communicates to a deity
referenced (CITED)≠	S I G H T E D (3,5)	# (SITED) located
small child (TOT)≠	T A U G H T (3,6)	# (TAUT) under high tension
work dough (KNEAD)≠	N E E D (2,3)	# (KNEED) struck with a leg joint
striped asphalt strip (ROAD)≠	R O D E (2,3)	# (ROWED) propelled by hand
seasonal illness (FLU)≠	F L E W (1,2)	# (FLUE) smoke escape route
fruity drink suffix (ADE)≠	A I D (1,2)	# (AIDE) assistant
shift-6 (CARET)≠	K A R A T (3,1)	# (CARAT) weight of gems but conspicuously not gold
not a vegetarian dish (MEAT)≠	M E T E (3,2)	# (MEET) to come together
sovereignty (REIGN)≠	R A I N (3,2)	# (REIN) animal guidance rope
turn solid (FREEZE)≠	F R E E S (5,1)	# (FRIEZE) decorative band beneath a cornice
trim down (PARE)≠	P A I R (2,3)	# (PEAR) pyriform fruit
black out words (CENSOR)≠	S E N S O R (3,4)	# (CENSER) ceremonial burner
ritual acts (RITES)≠	R I G H T S (6,4)	# (WRITES) composes text

The first of each pair of numbers indexes into the middle word to read “L E A G U E O F A R T I S A N S” and the second of each pair makes “S L I T T E D L I K E A F I S H”. These clue GUILD and GILLED, which have a triplet: GIID, which is the answer.
